TSCA - Toxic Substance Control Act (TSCA), Section 6(h)

The TSCA regulations, published by the U.S. EPA (Environmental Protection Agency) on 06.01.2021 and relating to the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) Section 6(h), are intended to restrict the import into and use in the USA of five chemicals.

The aim of the TSCA regulation is to improve the protection of human health and the environment.

For implementation of the law, the EPA has published a list of those chemicals which are suspected of causing cancer or of being toxic for reproduction.
